## TOWER BRIDGE

It is a bascule bridge built over the River Thames. It was inaugurated in 1894 and is currently one of the most visited attractions of the city, besides being known as one of the world's most famous bridges.

It is located next to the Tower of London.

## LONDON EYE

Also known as the Millennium Wheel (Millennium Wheel), is a Ferris wheel observation. Located in the city of London, the UK capital, was inaugurated in 1999 and is one of the most disputed city sights. Full back lasts around 30 minutes, long enough to enjoy the beautiful view of the city in 360 ° weather.

The nearest tube stations are Waterloo and Westminster.

## PICCADILLY CIRCUS

It is one of the busiest areas of the British capital, the area is surrounded by several tourist attractions, including a statue of Eros, bars and theaters of London's West End, including the "Criterion Theatre" which is located here, Leicester Square and several shops.
